

This is what **you should** do if you find fruit infested with medfly in your house or area.



DOs

- ✓ Kill medfly maggots
- ✓ Reduce adult fly numbers



Medfly attack more than 250 different fruits, preferring hard or semi-ripe fruit over soft, ripe fruit. But this preference can vary within regions and within seasons. They can be especially damaging to citrus, stone fruits, pome fruits, tomatoes and figs.

The most effective way to control medfly is to stop them from infesting other fruit.

DON'Ts

- ✗ Throw infested fruit with maggots on the ground or in the rubbish bin
- ✗ Leave fruit on the tree or on the ground
- ✗ Bring fruit to orchards or fruit growing areas
- ✗ Remove traps and baits from trees
- ✗ Mix fruit with live maggots directly into the compost
